Tips for reading and leisure

The exhibition "Counter Thoughts. Counter Images" by artist Cheryl McIntosh explores the traces of colonialism in Bonn. With her works, Cheryl McIntosh makes a powerful statement against colonialism, racism, oppression and for resistance against colonial structures. Mixed-media collages, large-scale installations as well as various textiles and materials enable a diverse approach to Bonn's past and present.

Interested parties can visit the exhibition from March 1st to 28th 2024 at the Ernst-Moritz-Arndt-Haus, Adenauerallee 79. Admission is free.

As part of the International Weeks against Racism, the Office for Integration and Diversity in cooperation with the Bonn Adult Education Centre will be showing the exhibition "What You Don't See" at the Haus der Bildung as from March 13th.

The exhibition makes everyday racism visible by depicting situations in which children, teenagers and adults have personally experienced racism, whether on the street, on buses and trains, at school, at work, in shops or elsewhere. The exhibition is intended to provide food for thought to act and speak differently. At the same time, the aim is to send a signal that people who experience racism are not alone.

The Deutsche Kinderhilfswerk is launching a media quiz on its children's website especially for children with little knowledge of German. The target group of the four-month project of the Deutsche Kinderhilfswerk are children and young people from 8 to 16 years of age with a migrant background and from refugee families. The online quiz, which has been specially developed for children and young people with little knowledge of German, is ideally suited to promote technical and media literacy in a targeted manner due to its simple language.
