At the schools, our project "My first library" is starting up again. Those reading mentors who continue to read with the children from the last school year, have already started reading with their children again. Exceptions are those books which are marked with the sticker "This book belongs to the association Kultur verbindet! Please put it back in the box after reading" (Dieses Buch gehört dem Verein Kultur verbindet! Bitte nach dem Durchlesen wieder in die Kiste zurücklegen)".

Due to Corona, we still have many books in stock, which will not get any better by storing them for ages! So please let the child take the book home when you finished reading it.

In the coming months, an open day will take place at almost all the schools with which we cooperate. At the Elsa Brändström School we will be represented with an information booth. We hope that we can win even more new reading mentors for the schools.

Book recommendation: Kasi Kauz and the strange crow by O. Wnuk

A strange crow has appeared in the forest. It has bright colorful feathers and his screams are loud and shrill. The forest animals are worried. Susi Wild Boar fears that the crow could be dangerous for her family. Squirrel Flitz is afraid for his nut supply. The duck Mrs. Schnatter-Schnabel is envious of the colorful plumage. And Mr. Spatz is jealous because his wife, Mrs Spatz makes eyes at the strange animal. Luckily, Kasi Kauz knows how to listen really well ...

A poetic and child-friendly story about dealing with the fear of the unknown, suitable for reading aloud to children from the age of 5. This book is a plea for courage and curiosity. And for the openness to approach others.
